We are pleased to return to Grant Park, the premier venue for an outdoor music festival. Your neighborhood provides the perfect showcase to display the beauty and welcoming sentiment of Chicagoans. We appreciate your hospitality, support, cooperation and understanding during our festival weekend. Chicago continues to be a wonderful host to Lollapalooza, now in our 13th year. As a courtesy and show of continuing cooperation, it is important to us to share with our neighbors some of the details for this year's Festival.

Lollapalooza will take place from Thursday, August 3rd at 11:00AM to Sunday, August 6th at 10:00PM. The venue closes each evening at 10:00PM. The overall footprint of the event has not changed. - **Columbus, from Monroe to Roosevelt:** July 31st at 8pm thru August 7th at 11:59pm
- **Congress Parkway, from Michigan to Columbus:** July 31st at 8pm thru August 7th at 11:59pm
- **Monroe (Eastbound), from Columbus to Lake Shore Drive:** July 27th at 12:01am thru August 9th 11:59pm
- **Lake Shore Drive (Southbound), from Monroe to Roosevelt:** August 1st at 11:00pm to August 7th at 7:00am

- **Balbo (Both sides), from Columbus to Lake Shore Drive:** July 19th at 12:01am thru August 10th at 11:59pm
- **Columbus (Southbound side), from Balbo to Roosevelt:** July 24th at 12:01am thru August 10th at 11:59pm
- **Jackson (Both sides), from Columbus to Lake Shore Drive:** July 25th at 8pm to August 9th at 11:59pm
- **Lake Shore Drive (Northbound side), from Monroe to Roosevelt:** July 26th at 9am thru July 26th at 5pm
- **Monroe (Eastbound side), from Columbus to Lake Shore Drive:** July 27th at 12:01am thru August 9th at 11:59pm
- **Lake Shore Drive (Southbound side), from Monroe to Roosevelt:** July 29th at 12:01am thru August 12th at 11:59pm
- **Balbo (Both sides), from Michigan to Columbus:** July 31st at 8pm thru August 7th at 11:59pm
- **Jackson (Both sides), from Michigan to Columbus:** July 31st at 8pm to August 7th at 11:59pm
- **Congress Parkway/Circle, from Michigan to Columbus:** July 31st at 8pm thru August 7th at 11:59pm
- **Columbus (Both sides), from Monroe to Roosevelt:** July 31st at 8pm thru August 7th at 11:59pm
- **Lake Shore Drive (Northbound side), from Monroe to Roosevelt:** August 8th at 9am thru August 8th at 5pm
- *Pedestrians will not be allowed access to the Museum Campus Tunnel*
- *To access the lakefront along this closure, pedestrians must use the East sidewalk of Michigan to access the north sidewalk of Monroe*

We have worked very closely with the Mayor's Office, the Office of Alderman Brendan Reilly and Alderman Sophia King, and the City's First Responders to ensure that we have a plan in place which maximizes convenience to all of our neighbors and minimizes overall impact to the street grid and circulation patterns for area residents and businesses. We have coordinated breakdown of the venue to restore your sidewalks, streets and parkways back to you as soon as possible.

Your neighborhood will be enjoyed by thousands of music lovers; we hope you are among them. Rest assured, security, police, and other safety personnel are in place to ensure the entire neighborhood enjoys this celebration in a peaceful and safe manner.
